"What? Chris, is here—that's great!"

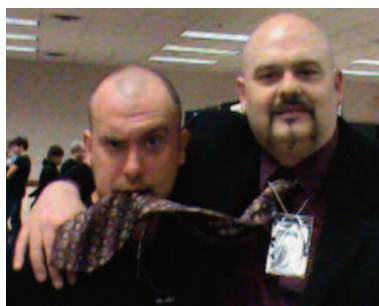
